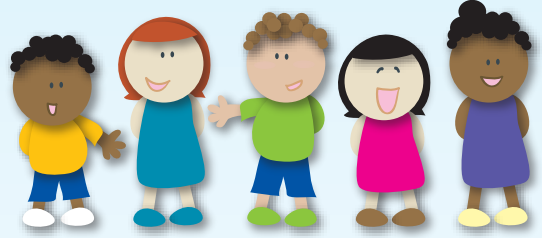


Conversation Starters



Engage your child in conversation every day. Having conversations with your child develops language skills, social skills, and new vocabulary. Instead of asking, "What did you do in school today?" try asking what he or she liked most about school today. Then share what you liked most about your day. Some additional conversation starters include:

- What was your favorite part of the day?
- Tell me about your painting/drawing/artwork.
- Tell me about one thing that happened at school today.
- What is your favorite color? Do you see anything around that is that color?
- Tell me about the weather today. What do you think the weather will be like tomorrow?
- What is your favorite storybook? Why?
- Tell me about the family poster/Discoveries-to-Go/storybook that was sent home today.
- What is your favorite toy? Why?
- Let's do something fun tomorrow. What should we do? Where should we go?
- What makes you angry? Why?
- Tell me about your favorite animal.
- If our family could have any animal in the world as a pet, what would you like to have? Why?
- What is the nicest thing you did for someone today?
- If you could be any kind of food, what would you choose to be? Why?
- What made you smile today?
- Show me one thing you did at school today.
